"Association for the global fight against poverty, promoting social, educational and environmental development"

Chay Ya is a non-profit organization, working closely with mountain communities to identify their needs and develop economically and culturally viable solutions.

Chay Ya is operating mainly in the Nepalese Himalaya and mid hills. Mountain and mid-hills of Nepal are generally considered the least developed region of Nepal. Chay Ya works in collaboration with Government Organizations, I/NGOs, CSOs, and Companies having similar goals and objectives. The organization focuses on building the capacity of rural societies to respond the emerging socioeconomic, environmental, health and education problems.

The project activities include education for children, building basic health care system, environmental conservation and immediate humanitarian relief. Training is also provided to the teachers of rural schools.

Chay Ya provides health facilities in rural and remote regions of Nepal by establishing health centers and organizing health camps by Nepali and Foreign doctors, and medical practitioners. Chay Ya in its coming years plans to focus on entrepreneurship and a livelihood improvement program.

### **Objectives**

The following are the set of objectives through which Chay Ya aims to achieve its mission:

- Develop education and health services with the necessary infrastructure support
- Conduct research on emerging socio-economic and environmental problems and develop effective knowledge and understanding to address the problems
- Organize awareness and relief distribution programs to respond to disaster aid requirements
- Organize capacity building programs for children, women and marginalized groups
- Assist, facilitate and support poor, vulnerable and disadvantaged people on building their livelihoods





## Areas of focus

# Health Service



Chay Ya organizes frequent free health camps in the mid-hills and Himalayan regions of Nepal. It incorporates national and international doctors and medical practitioners to provide health facilities to the people residing in the remote regions of Nepal. It conducts free health check-ups and distribution of free medicines to the people, also promoting health and hygiene awareness classes in the health camps.

A Birthing and Outreach Center is under construction Chekampar-6, Lar, Tsum Valley. Chay Ya is sponsoring a Tsum Valley local in a Health Assistant (HA) study in Kathmandu, who will then work at the Center after the completion of the study.

#### Education

Chay Ya works to improve education, thus providing opportunities for the poor and remote children of Himalayas. The organization fosters quality education in remote schools by recruiting qualified school teachers and providing school uniforms and stationary to the children.

Chay Ya began to restore and repair the school buildings damaged by the disastrous earthquake of April 2015 in Nepal. Upon completion of the project, affected students will be shifted from temporary learning centers to the permanent school buildings. The restoration of school project is underway in the Gorkha and Rasuwa districts of Nepal.



## School Sports Project

Chay Ya promotes Sports in the rural mountain schools. The major objective of this project is to teach and train sports activities to the school children residing in remote areas. It encourages parents and kids to enroll into the schools, ultimately for education. The objective is to increase the number of students attending schools for sports and education.

Tsum Valley Schools Sports Project is underway in schools in Tsum Valley, Gorkha. The organization had employed well-trained and skilled sports teachers. The school students are



trained in athletics, football, volleyball, badminton, and physical training exercises. Tsum Valley Schools Sports Project is sponsored by the Sports Ministry of Austria.

## Disaster Relief Program

Chay Ya supports the disaster relief programs, providing immediate relief aid to people to help cope with the impact of disaster and re-build their lives.

The organization distributed foodstuffs, housing materials, and clothes to the people affected by April 2015 Earthquake in Nepal. CGI sheets, blanket, tarpaulins, rice, lentils, noodle, salt, vegetable oil and mosquito coils were distributed to the earthquake affected families in Nepal. Distribution covered the extremely affected eight districts of Nepal: Gorkha, Rasuwa, Bhaktapur, Sindhupalchowk, Kavrepalanchowk, Kathmandu, Dolakha and Kaski district.
